

Past tense simple of regular verbs - Pretekli čas pravih glagolov

○ PAST TENSE, -ED ENDING, -ED, DID, DID NOT, DIDN'T

Če želim v sedanjem času **povedati**, da **igram** nogomet, rečem:

- I **play** football. *Igram nogomet.*

Kako pa povem, da **sem** nogomet **igral**, pa ga ne igram več?

Dejanje je **za nami**, zato **za glagol** damo končnico **-ED**

PLAY + **ED** = PLAY**ED**

- I play**ed** football. *Igral sem nogomet.*

Če te želim v sedanjem času **vprašati**, ali igraš nogomet, rečem:

- **Do** you **play** football? *Ali igraš nogomet?*

Kako pa vprašam, ali **si igral** nogomet?

- **Did** you **play** football? *Ali si igral nogomet?*

Če želim v sedanjem času **zanikati**, da igram nogomet, rečem:

- I **don't play** football. *Ne igram nogometa.*

Kako pa to zanikam v preteklem času?

- I **did not play** football.
- I **didn't play** football. *Nisem igral nogometa.*

Did I play football?	I played football.	I didn't play football.
Did you play football?	You played football.	You didn't play football.
Did he play football?	He played football.	He didn't play football.

Nekaj primerov glagolov v preteklem času:

work - work**ed**, wash - wash**ed**, clean - clean**ed**

Nekaj posebnosti v pisavi:

- live - lived**d**, move - moved**d** (dodamo samo d)
- marry - married**d**, study - studied**d** (y gre v i)
- travel - travel**led**, stop - stop**ped** (podvojen soglasnik)



Kaj znam

Glagoli v pretekliku dobijo končnico -ED.
Play + ed = played
